# Peer support that **walks the road** with you.

The **Reintegration Project** (trading as The Green Collar) delivers NDIS-funded peer support for justice-affected men and women, people with lived experience of addiction, mental ill-health, or institutional disconnection. Our team has been there — and we know how to build the bridge back to purpose, connection and employment.

**Typical commitment:** 2-3 hours per week, including remote support, for 4-6 weeks. That's usually the window where we see connection, confidence and perspective start to shift.

## 1:1 PEER SUPPORT

Personalised mentoring with someone who genuinely understands. Court support, appointments, daily structure, and the hard conversations no one else is having.

## GROUP & SHARED ACTIVITIES

Green Collar Brigade volunteering days, weekly online "Green & Clean" Zooms, community connection events — purpose-built to lift isolation and rebuild routine.
